

## Receiving the Book of Redemption

### REVELATION 5:1-4

<sup>1</sup>And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. <sup>2</sup>And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? <sup>3</sup>And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon. <sup>4</sup>And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

### PHILIPPIANS 4:3

<sup>3</sup>And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life.

### EXODUS 32:31-32

<sup>31</sup>And Moses returned unto the LORD, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold. <sup>32</sup>Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin--; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written.

<sup>1</sup>This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; <sup>2</sup>Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created. <sup>3</sup>And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth: <sup>4</sup>And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters: <sup>5</sup>And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died.

## **63-0317E - THE BREACH BETWEEN THE SEVEN CHURCH AGES AND THE SEVEN SEALS**

44) Now, we see that this seven-sealed Book now, is the mystery of redemption. It's a Book of Redemption from God.

### **65-0221E - WHO IS THIS MELCHISEDEC**

116) ...Because, the very word redeem means "to bring back." Is that right? The redeem is something... To redeem anything, is, "bring it back to its original place."

### **65-0801E - EVENTS MADE CLEAR BY PROPHECY**

16) For the Bible is a living, foretold witness of Jesus Christ. And as the earth has grown into its fullness, and also vines grow into their fullness, the day grows into its fullness, the Bible was manifested in its fullness in the Person of Jesus Christ. He was the Word of God revealed, the whole complete Book of Redemption.

### **63-0317E - THE BREACH BETWEEN THE SEVEN CHURCH AGES AND THE SEVEN SEALS**

145) And the whole thing here, the Seven Seals got the mysteries of God from the foundation of the world all sealed up in there, and revealed by Seven different Seals; that if God willing--let Him--let us pull back these Seals and look down through the Book and find out what it's all about. See? Oh, I hope we have a great time. There the mystery of redemption is sealed until... This Book could not be broken until the last angel's message. The scroll's there; we knowed it was there. We know that it was redemption. We believed it was redemption.

### REVELATION 5:5-7

<sup>5</sup>And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof. <sup>6</sup>And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. <sup>7</sup>And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

### **65-1031M - POWER OF TRANSFORMATION**

124) Now if children has come up under that kind, see, under that kind of teaching, that's what their parents was, they have the nature of their parents, their denominations, and so forth, they have to believe that. See, they believe that because they're borned under that parent. But today we're not borned under that parent; our Parent is the Word. And the Word... "Well," say, "I was borned under God, too." For that age. But this is the climax age, this is the age beyond those denominations.

125) There had to come forth, must come forth; God ordained it so, that there must come forth, them Seven Seals must be opened. It was supposed to be done in this Laodicean age.

### **63-0320 - THE THIRD SEAL**

39) And the... John said everybody in heaven, everything beneath the earth, and everything heard him praising God about it. John must've found his name on there, you know... And all that time...

Then he said, "He is worthy to take the Book of Redemption." Now, it doesn't belong back to the Judge any more. It belongs to the Redeemer, and He's done done the work of redemption.

Now, He's going to show the church what He done. See? Then He just takes... But the Book is closed. No one knowed at all. They know it was a Book of Redemption on it there, but it's to be revealed in the last days according to Revelations 10. The seventh angel is going to be given the message of that, because it said that in the time of the sounding of the seventh church age--the seventh angel, when he sounds, all the mysteries of God should be finished up by his sounding.

### DANIEL 12:8-9

<sup>8</sup>And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, what shall be the end of these things? <sup>9</sup>And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.

## REVELATION 10:1-4

<sup>1</sup>And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire: <sup>2</sup>And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth, <sup>3</sup>And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices. <sup>4</sup>And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

### **63-0318 - THE FIRST SEAL**

167) But think, now he wrote this, but when he started to write those other seven thunders, he said, "Don't write it." He'd been commissioned to write everything he seen. But when these seven thunders over in Revelations 10 uttered, he said, "Don't write them at all." They're mysteries. We don't know what they are yet; but my opinion they'll be revealed right away. And when it do, it'll give faith for that rapturing grace for that Church to move out. We just move through everything that we know of; through all the dispensations we've watched everything. We've seen the mysteries of God. We've seen the appearing of the great gathering together of the Bride in the last days, but yet there's something in there that we just can't lighten ourself with. There's something another. But I imagine when them mysteries begins to come forth... God said, "Hold it back now. Wait a minute. I'll reveal it in that day. Don't write it at all, John, 'cause they'll stagger over it. Just let it go. (See?) But I'll reveal it in that day when it has need to done."

They never uttered for nothing. You remember, like the little drop of ink, everything is for a purpose. Everything's for a cause. But notice, the Creator uttered, and he had a--he heard this voice, and he went to see.

171) But now the Lamb is showing John in the symbol of a church Scripture like, for the church (you know) what to write. He just show him, said, "Now, don't tell this, just what it is. Don't go down, John, and say, 'Now, this is just what this is.' Now, what's under this Seventh Seal, don't go down and tell that, for if I tell John that, then all down through the age the whole plan will be broke: it's a secret."

### **LAODICEAN CHURCH AGE - CHURCH AGE BOOK**

324-1) It was in the end-time period that the seven thunders of Jesus came forth. Revelation 10:3-4, *"And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices. And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not."*

What was in those thunders no one knows. But we need to know. And it will take a prophet to get the revelation because God has no other way of bringing out His Scriptural revelations except by a prophet.

### **63-0728 - CHRIST IS THE MYSTERY OF GOD REVEALED**

203) All those things typed Him, just in type, but yet the mystery was hid. Them men didn't know what they were doing. They only knew that they were led by the Spirit to do some. Now, holding it back in the last days, for the great revelation. But, expressing it, express Himself in Moses, and David, and Joseph, and Elijah, and on down through. You... we could take each one of those prophets, and bring their lives out and show it expressed Jesus Christ perfectly, exactly, **yet never giving His secret in full; waiting for to make it known in the last days as He promised, waiting for it to be fully comprehended**, see, before He could express it, if He told the whole thing. Because, the Bible is written in mysteries. Jesus thanked the Father for it, see, that It was wrote in mysteries.

205) Now, the Coming of the Lord is in mystery. We don't know when He's coming, how He's coming, but we know He is coming. See? **And so was all the mysteries of God waiting for this last day**. After He's already been completed, then He reveals and shows what He's done. Oh, my! Never gave His mystery in full.

## **65-0218 - THE SEED IS NOT HEIR WITH THE SHUCK**

128) Neither will a Christian eat on that dead a carrions from old denominational doctrines and things. They want the Word of God, fresh, the promise of the hour. God promised rabbits in the days of Luther. He promised other things in the days of others. **But now He promised us a full square Meal, the full seven course Menu, for all the Seven Seals are opened, and everything is ready for the Word of God, to those who can receive!**

### REVELATION 10:8-11

<sup>8</sup>And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth. <sup>9</sup>And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey. <sup>10</sup>And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter. <sup>11</sup>And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

### HEBREWS 2:10-11

<sup>10</sup>For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. <sup>11</sup>For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,
